1 Introduction

The accepted papers will be published in the Conference proceedings by the journal of Dynamics of Continuous, Discrete and Impulsive Systems, Series A (DCDIS-A). The authors are requested to follow the submission instructions on the conference website. It is highly recommended that the authors use LATEX to prepare the final manuscripts, which should be no longer than 6 pages in standard conference two-column format. Extra pages will be charged at a rate of US\$100 per page.

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2 Text

Contributions to **DYNAMICS OF CONTINUOUS, DISCRETE AND IMPULSIVE SYSTEMS** must be in English and manuscripts should be typed (using LaTeX, or AMS-LaTeX) single-sided on white paper with dark, sharp and clear letter quality type. The print size should be **10** pt. Manuscripts should be typed with **7** inch textwidth and **10** inch textheight. Please make sure that the equations and figures do not run off the margins.

The first page should have a 2.25 inch top margin. The title of the manuscript should be \large, centered, all caps

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Paragraphs should have 0.3 inch indent except the first paragraph in a section or after an expression or figure.

Equations should be centered with the number of the equation placed in parentheses at the right margin.

Figures and Tables should be placed as part of the text with descriptive captions and should be numbered consecutively.
